### Holmes Chapel Show.

#### Rules

- All exhibitors must complete an entry form and send to HC Partnership – Show, 31 Alumbrook Ave, Holmes Chapel CW4 7BX to be received no later than 6 September 2017.
- Exhibitors may only enter one exhibit per class. Adult Classes 1 – 39. Young Persons, 16 years and under, Classes 40 – 52.
- All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor only and made within the last two years.
- Exhibits to be staged at HC Community Centre on Sunday 17 September between 9.00am and 10.30am.
- The show organisers are the sole authority in arranging how or where exhibits are to be shown and have the right to refuse an entry.
- The judges decisions are final.
- No exhibit may be removed until 5.00pm on Sunday. Whilst every care will be taken, the organisers do not accept responsibility for any loss or damage from any cause to exhibits or containers. Exhibits will be disposed of if not collected by 5.00pm.

flowers costing no more than £5  
Space allowed 40cm
- Class 12 an arrangement in a cup and saucer

#### HORTICULTURE

- Class 13 5 runner beans
- Class 14 5 potatoes – any variety
- Class 15 plate of 5 tomatoes
- Class 16 3 onions -any variety
- Class 17 a collection of herbs – named
- Class 18 5 apples
- Class 19 any other vegetable not specified above
- Class 20 a display of a collection of 4 kinds of  
vegetables, 3 of each kind
- Class 21 5 different stems of flowers – in a vase
- Class 22 1 specimen rose
- Class 23 1 flowering plant
- Class 24 1 foliage plant

### **NATURAL HISTORY**

Class 44 collection of shells, flowers, grasses or leaves  
Class 45 a vegetable animal

### **HANDICRAFTS**

Class 46 paint a paper plate  
Class 47 a model made from recycled materials  
Class 48 any other handicraft – not from a kit

### **PAINTING**

No larger than A3 and mounted on a slightly larger sheet of paper or card. Your age should be displayed on your exhibit
