

Traffic & Transport Survey

A really big thank you to everyone who completed the questionnaire on the issues affecting the village.

In total we had 669 questionnaires completed, with most of them done online.

The Traffic & Transport Working Group (all volunteers) have now summarised the results of the survey.

The results will soon be available on the Parish Council website for you to see. We will also have a physical display of the results in the Library W/C 26th November and the Parish Office on December 2nd for the Christmas Market.

Overall the results demonstrate the concerns you have about traffic levels and hotspots, the number of HGV's, air quality and pedestrian safety issues around the village, together with the extent of support for a village bypass and pedestrianisation of the village centre. Cycling was viewed as too dangerous by many people.

The results will be used to demonstrate to Cheshire East Council that our residents fully support the Parish Council's efforts to address these issues. We will keep you up to date on the progress we make.
