 - Planters are with Channel Island plants to be planted and installed around the village centre in late May. Ian Petherick has confirmed he will water again this summer and has submitted invoices for 2016.
 - 20mph zones outside HCCS and HC Primary School are in the programme for completion by the end of March 2017.
 - Street lighting – to note Jubilee Walk and Sutton Oaks have been changed to LED lighting. The heritage lamps in the centre of the village will not be altered.

Appendix 1

I am wondering whether the same could be done near the Comprehensive School, to limit inconsiderate/dangerous parking – specifically:

- At the junction of Portree Drive and Selkirk Drive – vehicles are frequently parked all day opposite Portree Drive, making driving to/from Selkirk Drive extremely difficult, especially for large vehicles (delivery vehicles, cars with caravans/trailer, motorhomes, etc.). This is exacerbated by the right hand curve opposite the entrance to the school which hinders visibility from and towards the Portree Drive junction.
- At the junction of Portree Drive and Nairn Avenue. At school times, there are frequently parent parked on the pavement in Nairn Avenue, making passage along that road, and negotiation of the junction difficult.

The – hopefully temporary - loss of our PCSO also means that, regardless of such zones, these areas are not to my knowledge being policed. I am not suggesting any ban on parents parking/dropping off their children, but the combination of frequent inconsiderate parking by some, and all day parking by persons unknown (students/teachers?) is making this an increasing problem.

Please let me know what you think, and perhaps you can advise how this is best taken forward?

Appendix 2

Poster competition

Problems with dog walkers not picking up their dog's poo has been discussed on many occasions by the Parish Council and on social media. This can be both dangerous and unsightly.

In order to try to highlight the problem the parish council and police would like both primary schools to create an A4 poster. The winning poster for each school will be posted around the relevant side of the village to try to encourage dog walkers to be responsible owners. Cheshire East Council have approved the idea.

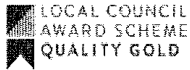
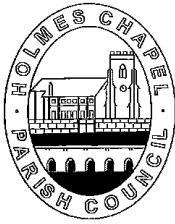

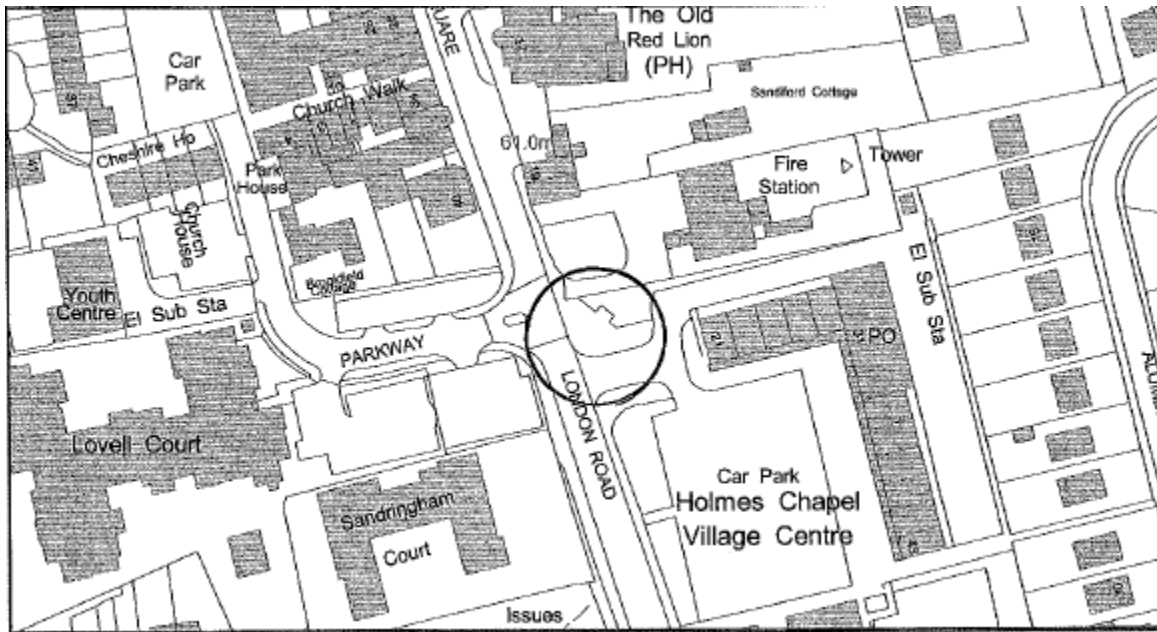
