Holmes Chapel Parish Council have decided to establish a youth council. Its objectives are to:

- Introduce the young people of Holmes Chapel to the processes of local government by directly involving them in the activities of the Parish Council;
- Ascertain the views of young people regarding the current and future issues facing the parish council and the village in general;
- Initiate and manage projects of interest to the young people of Holmes Chapel;
- Encourage future potential parish councillors.

Membership of the youth council will be open to everyone in one or more of the following groups:

- Residents of Holmes Chapel parish aged from 10 to 19, inclusive;
- Students attending Holmes Chapel Comprehensive School and Sixth Form College;
- Students in the final year at Holmes Chapel Primary School and Hermitage Primary School;
- Members of recognised youth organisations operating in Holmes Chapel, who are aged from 10-19 inclusive.

To get the council started we are holding a general meeting at 6pm on Monday 25th February at the Holmes Chapel Community Centre. The meeting is open to everybody in one or more of the groups listed above. Parents or those with parental responsibilities may attend provided they are accompanied by at least one young person belonging to one of the listed groups.

In order to comply with our safeguarding policy those wishing to attend must complete and submit a registration form prior to the meeting; and by 21st February at the latest. For those aged 16 or under, a parent or person with parental responsibilities must sign the form. Further copies of the form can be downloaded from the Parish Council website or obtained from the Parish Council office.
